Rules and Regulations

1. Objectives

The Competition aims in its efforts:

- i) To give chance for each student to compete at National level.
- ii) To promote and advocate the learning of Abacus and Mental Arithmetic.
- iii) To elevate the standard of performance of learners of Abacus and Mental Arithmetic.
- To foster a closer relationship between the Course Instructors and students of various centers.
- v) To certify one's capability in Abacus or Mental Arithmetic.

2. Administrative Details

Competition Date, Time & Venue

Date: 27th January 2023 - Friday Time: 9:30 AM onwards

Venue: Peddem Indoor Stadium, Mapusa, on Mumbai Goa Highway, Goa

Prize Distribution Ceremony Date, Time & Venue

Date: 29th January 2023 - Sunday Time: 9:00 AM onwards

Venue: Peddem Indoor Stadium, Mapusa, on Mumbai Goa Highway, Goa

Marks for all Levels

Each sum in Addition / Subtraction (+, -) = 1 marks

Each sum in Multiplication/Division (x, /) = 1 mark

3. SPECIAL NOTE INTO competition.

- a. There are total 10 main groups ... Z, A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H & I, these main groups further divides into 30 subgroups as per students age & their currently learning level of abacus.
- b. The number of sums for all groups will be 150 sums, each sum carry one mark.
- c. The time limit for all the groups will be 8 minutes.

4. Eligibility

- Groups will be finalized as per certificate of District/State Level Abacus & Mental Arithmetic Competition 202 as Z,A,B,C,D,E,F,G,H,I & consent letter from Centre In charge
- A student can appear in one group only.
- No student will be permitted to appear for level/s lower than the normal (as per the above mentioned rule), quoting discontinuation / break as the reason would not be taken as an excuse.
- 3 months per term yardstick will be strictly followed.

5. Validation and Disqualification

In case a student is found to be admitted into lower category of competition than actual completed level,

i. Student will not be issued hall ticket.

ii. The Centre concerned shall be notified in letter of warning and will be automatically disqualified for the "Best Performance Centre Award" and made to face the other consequences as may be decided by the committee.

6. Judging

- a. Question and answer sheets are the property of GalaxyAbacus Corporate office and shall not be circulated after the exam even on request.
- b. There will be a panel of judges from the GalaxyAbacus corporate office.
- c. In the event of a tie amongst the participants,
 - i. The jury will rank the participants based on accuracy rate or the highest score in addition / subtraction.
 - ii. In case the tie persists, the lower age student will be declared winner
 - iii. If a tie still persists all will be declared as winners.
- d. The decision of the jury is final and no further correspondences shall be entertained.
- e. In case any parent wishes to apply for rechecking of the answer sheet, they may do so, after one week from the date of competition, by making a written request & paying a rechecking fee of Rs. 600/- per student. Rechecking will be done by a panel of judges and the result of rechecking will be informed to the parent.

7. Prizes

- **a.** Trophies will be awarded to Champion, I Runner up, II Runner up, III Runner up, IV Runner up, V Runner up in each group, by the chief guest on the stage itself.
- **b.** In addition to the trophy, the champion of champion will be declared for each group based on age and score will be given a special gift.
- **c.** After isolating Champion & Runner-up prizes , upto 75% students of each group will receive well performer trophies .

8. Competition Fee

All applications together with the competition fees should be sent to corporate office. The competition fee prescribed by the corporate office is as follows:

- a. **Rs. 2300/- per student**. Participation fees along with applications for all participating students should be received before 30/12/2022.
- b. **Rs. 2800/- per student** if received at corporate office after the date 30/12/2022.

9. General Rules

- a. All applications received after the deadlines will be rejected.
- b. All incomplete / incorrect applications even though received in time will be rejected.
- c. Participants must wear provided T. Shirt.
- d. Students belonging to Z, A, B, C & D must bring their ABACUS.
- e. All students must bring the Hall ticket and pencils to the competition hall.
- f. All students should report at the designated time on the day of the competition.
- g. The student should submit the age proof to establish his correct Date of Birth by producing Birth Certificate / Aadhar card/ Passport etc.,
